## 'Building Women's Futures'

Our vision is that women achieve their potential, particularly in relation to their educational and vocational aspirations, through the provision of services that are accessible, inclusive and respectful of their stated needs.



The lifelong learning courses offered at Glasgow YWCA's Family Learning Centre are free and include computing skills, arts and crafts, relaxation and exercise, confidence building and child development. Our aim is to remove barriers to participation for young women that can exist when they wish to develop their skills or access further education, training or employment opportunities. We also operate a creche that is free for women accessing our courses, however due to a lack of funds we can only offer limited places.

The Family Learning Centre is open Monday to Friday 9am – 5pm, and secured funding last year that meant we could extend our opening hours on a Thursday to 8.30pm to include an evening English class and a street dance class, Y Dance, for young women aged 11-19.

In 2008-9:

- 362 people attended classes at the Family Learning Centre
  - 41% were women under 30
- Over 11 different ethnic heritage groups were represented
